An industry veteran with a passion for improving access and quality care, Joseph has vast experience in transformational leadership. He has brought this expertise to his Board participation with national, university and various non-profit organizations. He is founder and President and CEO of J Scott Advisors. His vast healthcare experience includes system wide leadership in his role as Executive Vice President. He served as the President and CEO of 2 hospitals and a healthcare system. He has led mergers, integrations and turnaround of healthcare systems and launched far reaching community health initiatives. His passion for creating programs and services for the most vulnerable populations by anchoring his institutions directly impacted the wellbeing of the communities he served. His direct clinical experience as a Pharmacist provided a deep understanding of the clinical aspects of healthcare.

As the Executive Vice President of Healthcare Transformation for RWJBarnabas Health, Joseph was the lead executive for Innovation, Strategic Planning and Population Health. Joseph was the main liaison for invested Venture Capital Partners. He integrated his work in strategic planning, and population health into evaluating promising healthcare ventures for the purpose of finding value-based solutions to a wide range of healthcare applications. He served as the health system representative on the Value Based Healthcare investors Alliance from Leavitt Venture Partners. He also served as an internal consultant to two system invested venture partners; Newark Venture Partners and Tech Council Ventures. As the lead for population health, he has negotiated value-based contracts. Under his leadership, the system is now managing 42,000 members of the employee health plan and participating in system wide governmental and commercial value-based programs.

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Prior to his current role, Joseph held a wide variety of senior healthcare executive positions. He served as the President and CEO of Liberty Health from 2008 through 2014 when he successfully integrated Liberty Health into the then Barnabas Health System. Prior to integration, he successfully turned the system around from a quality and safety, financial and patient and employee engagement perspective. He successfully improved the financial performance of the system and improved operating margin from a -5 to 3.5%. For two years after the merger his work was focused on fully integrating into the new system. In 2015, Jersey City Medical Center was awarded the Vision of Performance Excellence award, the state equivalent of the Malcolm Baldrige Award. Under his leadership the hospital received many awards including Magnet Designation, Leapfrog A for 15 of 16 scoring periods and has been designated a Leader in LGBTQ by the healthcare equality Index.

Prior to joining Liberty, Joseph was employed by the Broward Health System in Fort Lauderdale, where he held a wide variety of positions over a 22years ultimately serving as the CEO of Broward General Medical Center, the flagship facility of the system.

Joseph has served on many Boards. He is currently the immediate past Chairman of the Board of America's Essential Hospitals where he chaired the Compensation Committee, and the Policy Committee for this national organization of over 350 hospitals and health systems. He was appointed by the Governor to the Board of New Jersey City University where he serves as Chairman of the Planning Committee. He has a passion for serving the community and is on the Board of Big Brothers and Big Sisters of Hudson, Union and Essex Counties. He served as Chairman of the Board of the Hudson County Chamber of Commerce for 4 years and was largely responsible for the financial turnaround and viability of the Chamber. He also served as the immediate past chair of the Hospital Alliance of New Jersey.

Joseph is a national speaker on healthcare transformation. He recently conducted a webinar on Healthcare's changing needs in the New Normal. He was the keynote speaker for the New Jersey Tech Council and served on the healthcare transformation panel for Modern Healthcare. He presented with a distinguished panel including the CEO of Intermountain Health on Social Determinants of Health as a Strategic Asset. He served on the Population Health panel at the Vital 2019 conference.
